Most of this sensitive information can be kept securely in a lock box or with your Power-of-Attorney or Substitute Decision Maker.

- 1. Full legal name and residence
- 2. Birth date and place, birth certificate
- 3. Marriage certificate
- 4. Emergency contacts/family contact information
- 5. Social Security number
- 6. Employer(s) and dates of employment
- 7. Education and military records
- 8. Veterans benefits, Veteran Number
- 9. Sources of income and assets; investment income (stocks, bonds, property)
- 10. Insurance policies, bank accounts, deeds, investments, and other valuables
- 11. Most recent income tax return
- 12. Money owed, to whom, and when payments are due
- 13. Credit card account names and numbers
- 14. Safe deposit box key and information
- 15. Lawyer, financial advisor contact information
- 16. Will, beneficiary information
- 17. Power of attorney
- 18. Advance Directive/Living will/personal directive or durable power of attorney for health care
- 19. Where cash or other valuables might be kept in the home
- 20. Pharmacist, pharmacy contact information
- 21. List of medications
- 22. Physician and specialists contact information
- 23. Medical file/information
- 24. Funeral Arrangements (Where, Contact Persons)
- 25. Passwords (computer, banking, etc.)
- 26. Vial of Life
