Can be friends, family or chosen family.

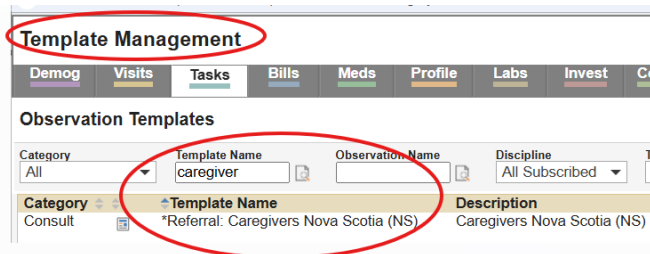
